2024-2025 Elite Tryout Process – U17 AAA

U17 AAA - 2nd Tryout Process

- Elite Male U17 AAA Player Movement (Draft Process) begins on Monday, September 9th, 2024.
- Players have the option to request a 2nd tryout with another elite club or to continue within their resident club AA tryout process. 2nd tryouts are **not guaranteed**. There are no 3rd tryouts.
- Players requesting a 2nd tryout have seven (7) days to arrange that tryout following the release from the 1st tryout team.
- It is the player's responsibility to look for and obtain a second tryout. You can do so by contacting the appropriate U17 AAA Registrar or Director directly.

 - b. Outside Edmonton:

- If a player is granted a second tryout, the parent/player must advise the releasing club registrar so that the Hockey Alberta Elite Male Waiver Form is initiated to start the movement process.
- Once the waiver is completed, parent/player will receive an automated form link for digital parent signature. Once completed and approved by Hockey Alberta, the player is required to print and present a copy of the completed waiver to the coach/club at the second tryout skate.
- Upon assignment of 2nd tryout, player will contact that club for tryout skate date and time.
- Upon the date of release the player has 7 days to return to their resident club if not rostered to another team.
- All U17 players awaiting a granted 2nd tryout are permitted to participate in their resident clubs AA tryout process until the 2nd AAA tryout date.

If a player fails to roster with the second tryout team, player then returns to their resident club for the AA tryout process.

Please note, it is highly recommended players keep in contact with their resident club to keep them updated on their U17 AAA 2nd tryout status.
